The Ombudsman's Office held a conference call to discuss the proceedings before it and met once in person during the reporting period.

One open case from 2019 was settled - by resolution.

In the calendar year 2020, 4 cases were brought to the attention of the Ombudsman's Office.

These were brought to an amicable resolution. Complaints of fundamental importance beyond the individual case were not submitted to the Ombudsman's Office in 2020.

Submissions continue to be made in German and English. Moreover, the Ombudsman's Office has established itself internationally.
